Sub: Collegiate Education Department-Scholarships to children/Grand children of political sufferers (Freedom Fighters) for the year2007-08--Applications invited.

Applications for scholarships payable to the students who are children of political sufferers (Freedom Fighters) or their grand children by pre-deceased sons undergoing studies for plus I course in Govt./Aided institutions and I year Degree/P.G. courses in colleges affiliated in the Universities in Kerala, during the year 2007-08, are invited. The scholarship is awarded for exempting them from payment of Tuition Fee. Hence, students who are enjoying any other fee concession will not be eligible for this scholarship. For a particular class of study, the scholarship will be paid only once. In other words, if a student is detained due to any reason in the same class during the subsequent year, scholarship will not be paid for that class again. But, when he/she is promoted to the next year of study for that course, scholarship is payable again.

The annual income of the present guardian of the student shall not exceed Rs.60000/- (Rs.sixty thousand). Alongwith the application, a certificate from the District Collector/RDO stating that the father/mother/grand father/grandmother of the student has been a political sufferer (Freedom Fighter), has to be enclosed. Further, besides the income certificate, the affidavit from the present guardian regarding his annual income, in the space provided in the application (signed before a Class I Magistrate) should be furnished.

The term Political Sufferer means a person who suffered imprisonment or detention for not less than 6 months, or who died or was killed in action or in detention, or was awarded capital punishment or become permanently incapacitated due to firing or lathi charges etc; or lost his job or means of livelihood or a part or whole of his property on account of participation in the National Movement for Emancipation of India.

The application for scholarship in the prescribed form alongwith the required documents are to be sent through the Head of Institution so as to reach the Special Officer for Scholarships, Directorate of Collegiate of Collegiate Education (Annex), Sanskrit College Campus, Palayam, Thiruvananthapuram - 34 on or before 31-01-2008. Application form can be downloaded from the department website www.collegiateedu.gov.in . On sending self-addressed envelope with postage stamp worth Rs.10/- affixed thereon, application will be made available through post also.

Displaced persons from East or West Pakistan who are Political Sufferers and persons who participated in the I.N.A. movement also will be treated as on par with other eligible

political sufferers provided their cases also fall within the scope of the prescribed definition of the term "Political Sufferer"
