**SCHEME OF POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS
BELONGING TO THE MONORITY COMMUNITIES**

Applications are invited from the students belonging to the minority communities notified by the Central Government under Section 2(c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992, who are pursuing higher education, from class XI up to Ph.D, including technical/vocational courses of Industrial Training Institutes/Industrial Training Centres (affiliated with NCVT) in Government school/college/institute or school/college/institute recognized by appropriate authority for post-matric scholarship to be awarded by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India. Courses other than those listed under merit-cum-means scholarship scheme, which is appended below, would be covered under the post-matric scholarship scheme. Application in the prescribed format along with requisite documents should be submitted to the department of Collegiate Education, Special Officer for Scholarships, Directorate of Collegiate Education Annexe, Sanskrit College Campus, Palayam, Trivandrum latest by 31/8/2008 through the Head of the school/college/institution of the student. The last date for the receipt of application is 31st August, 2008.

Object

The objective of the scheme is to award scholarship to the meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority communities to enable them to pursue higher education from class XI to Ph.D including technical/vocational courses of Class XI, Class XII level.

Conditions for scholarship

- (a) The scholarship is to be awarded for studies in India only.
- (b) To be eligible, students should have not less than 50%marks in the previous final examination. Students from BPL families, having the lowest income shall be given preference in the ascending order.
- (c) A scholarship holder under this scheme will not avail of any other scholarship/stipend for pursuing the same course.
- (d) The annual income, from all sources, of the student's parents or guardian should not exceed Rs.2 Lakh.
- (e) 30% of scholarships will be earmarked for girl students. In case girl students are not available then the scholarships earmarked for them will be awarded to eligible boy students.
- (f) Scholarships will not be given to more than two students in a family.
